Acceptable Art File Formats:

Adobe Illustrator (AI) format (PC or Mac) is the preferred format for graphical manipulation of your vector based artwork. If you are unsure, please feel free to send your questions, or artwork, to ArtDept@CenterMassInc.com for evaluation. Please review the following details and information to other acceptable formats.

Adobe Illustrator (AI): (preferred). All text must be converted to outlines unless specific font(s) is/are supplied for the project.

Adobe Acrobat PDF: Vector art saved as a PDF with full Illustrator editing capabilities. All text must be converted to outlines unless specific font(s) is/are supplied for the project.

Encapsulated Postscript (EPS): Please see https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Encapsulated_PostScript for additional details pertaining to applications and structure of EPS files. All text must be converted to outlines unless specific font(s) is/are supplied for the project.

Scalable Vector Graphics (SVG): Please see https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Scalable_Vector_Graphics for additional details pertaining to applications and structure of SVG files. All text must be converted to outlines unless specific font(s) is/are supplied for the project.

Unacceptable File Formats
